Educational Psychology covers five broad topics: development, learning, assessment, characteristics of learners, and lesson and classroom management. The development component focuses on developmental theories of cognition and affect as they relate to education. The classroom-management component focuses on the evaluation of learner characteristics to include ethnically diverse learners and learners with disabilities.
